**Homer Riesling** £29

**Ruca Malen Chardonnay, Mendoza Argentina** £30

*Fresh with well balanced acidity and sweet notes from the fruit. Persistent, pleasant and aromatic aftertaste.*

**Sancerre, Domaine du Nozay, Loire** £35

## Red wines by the bottle

### **The Southerly Shiraz, South Australia**

£25

*A fine core of black fruit and peppery notes, beautifully define this as a 'modern palate' / cool climate style which works well with beef, lamb and game. Medium bodied with heaps of silky textures and tannins.*

### **Sanziana Pinot Noir**

£23

*Layers of complex black cherry, raspberry and cinnamon with pretty fruit cake and deep spicy notes.*

### **Tinto Chocapalha, Portugal**

£30

*Situated in the outskirts of Aldeia Galega, the estate was donated to Diogo Duff, a Scottish Aristocrat (allegedly from the North East) ennobled by King D. João VI. Second generation, Sandra is now at the helm in the winery crafting outstanding wines with real balance, glorious fruit and a text book freshness.*

### **Cotes-du-Rhone Villages, Les Becs Fins, Rhone, France**

£26

*Deep plum-cherry, with a bright rim, this offers a gorgeous nose of plum, red and black fruit, pepper and spice. The palate takes up the reins, offering lovely berried character, pure, with a peppery backdrop - really good and persistent on the finish.*

### **Soraie 'Baby Amarone', Veneto, Italy**

£27

*Produced using the classic Venetian process of appassimento. Red fruits, plums, coffee and spice with a dusting of cocoa and black pepper flows effortlessly to crunchy, ripe fruit on a fresh, medium-bodied palate and length of silky fruit purity.*

### **Rioja Crianza, Vina Belezos, Bodegas Zugoiber, Rioja, Spain**

*Stunning Crianza from one of the new stars of the region. Definitely in the traditional style of Rioja but with a delicious fragrant and fresh angle.*

### **St. Emilion, Chateau Barrail du Blanc, Bordeaux**

### **Malbec, Achaval – Ferrer**

*One of the highest ranking Malbecs in Argentina. This wine is intense, deeply coloured and wonderfully complex with trademark velvety tannins.*
